Clallam County Planning Commission

Meeting of June 15, 2022, 6:00 PM

- A. CALL TO ORDER: The meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m.
- B. PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE.
- C. ROLL CALL: Members present were Vice-Chair Gale, Robert Miller, N. Bonnie Booth, M. Ingrid Carmean, Jeff Carter and Thomas Butler. Donella Clark, Principal Planner represented staff from the Department of Community Development.
- D. WELCOME: Vice-Chair Steve Gale welcomed all in attendance
- E. APPROVAL OF MINUTES: May 18, 2022
- F. ANNOUNCEMENTS: Jane Hielman has resigned from the Planning Commission, leaving the chair open. There are two vacancies in District 3 now. Commission took nominations and Steve Gale was nominated. Commission voted 5-0 with one abstention for Steve Gale to be the new chair, leaving the Vice-Chair position vacant. Ron Long was nominated as the Vice-Chair and a vote passed 6-0.
- G. PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD: Ken Reandeau informed the Planning Commission that there was a lively discussion at the Board of County Commissioners work session regarding the proposed Forestry Ordinance.

- J. WORK SESSION ITEMS: Beginning discussion on changes to the current Sign Ordinance, CCC 33.57. Staff reviewed the memo, referencing some history of the ordinance and issues related to the current code such as new technology of signs that the ordinance does not address. Each commissioner provided comment to help direct staff with changes to the ordinance. Commission would like to have a presentation from a sign company regarding the new technology and how to reduce light trespass and interference at intersections.
