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Attachment to the Agenda for the June Meeting of the
Clallam County Solid Waste Advisory Committee (SWAC)

This summary of previously raised questions to CoPA regarding contract termination, service transition and transfer stations operations, is being provided sufficiently far before the June 2022 SWAC meeting, to allow time for well considered responses, as suggested at the May meeting.

Q: What is the status of the services?

1. Trash hauling/disposal
2. Recycling: mixed, cardboard, glass, tires
3. Moderate Risk Waste/Asbestos
4. Co-composting

Q: What are the tonnage comparisons through May '22 compared to the last few years for the collected materials?

Q: What is the status? Who is doing due diligence of glass recycling? How can the public have input?

Q: How is curbside and drop box recycling being tipped and loaded for transport (e.g. separate baling facility or clearing the tip floor bay?) to minimize contamination and meet contract requirements?

Q: What is the status of the permits at the facilities and how have major changes like hauler access been resolved?

Q: What impacts to customers have been noted?

Q: Is yard waste being composted? If not, is stasis or fire a concern? Can compost be made without biosolids under permit?

Q: What is the timeline of biosolids going into the trash instead of being composted?

Q: How will decreased recycling (glass, biosolids) and increased trash (same materials, now disposed in trash) affect rates?
