The Park System Master Plan will guide investments to improve the park system and help the County pursue grants and other funding.

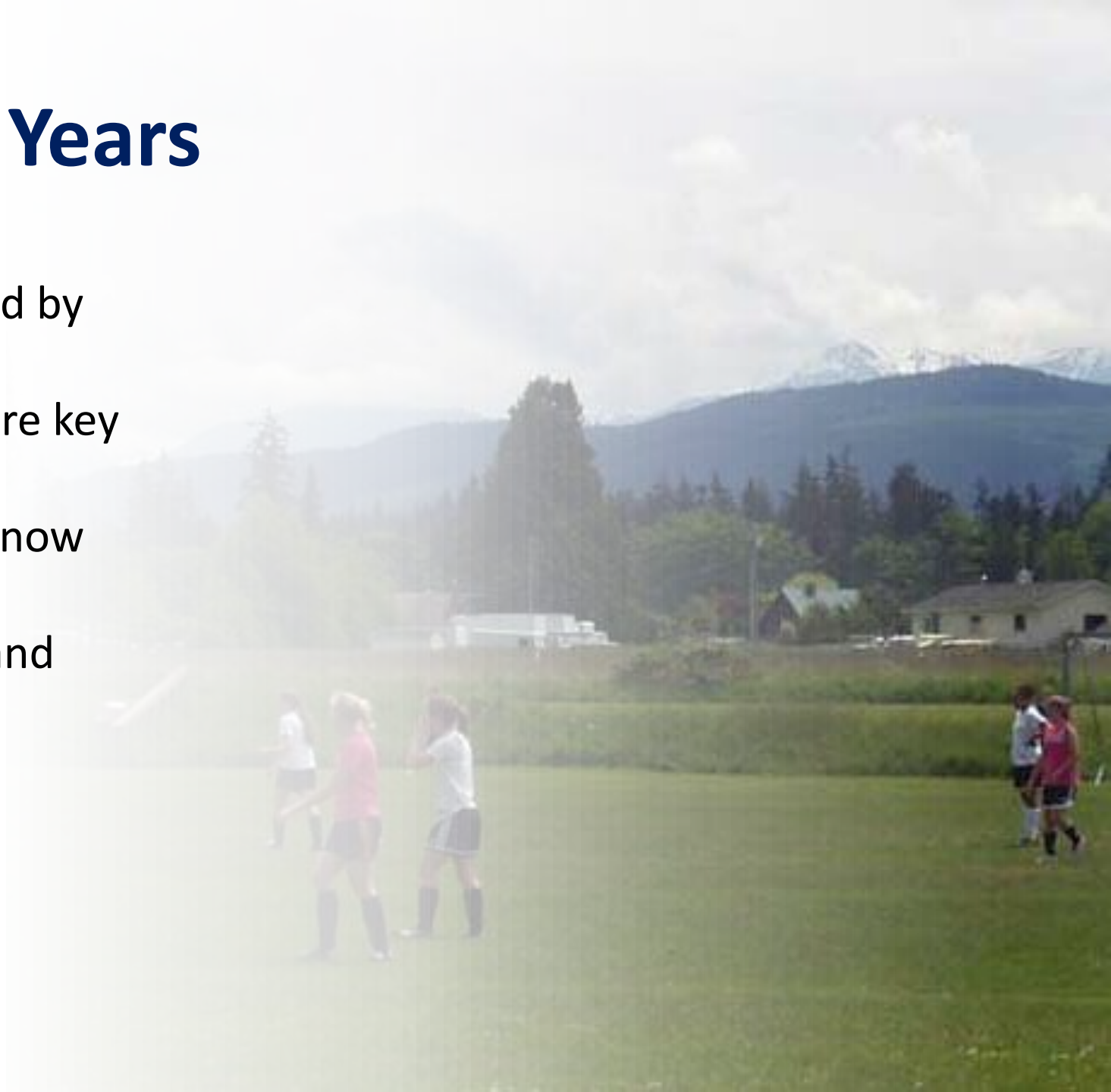


PSMP: The Next 10+ Years

The Plan is strategic in focus and guided by the following questions:

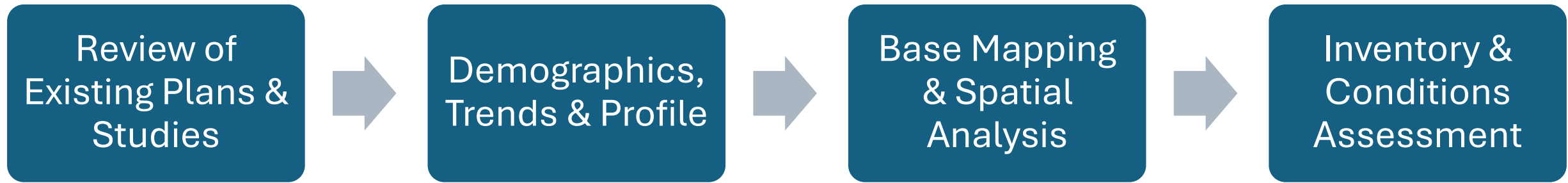
- What are our strengths? And what are key areas for improvement?

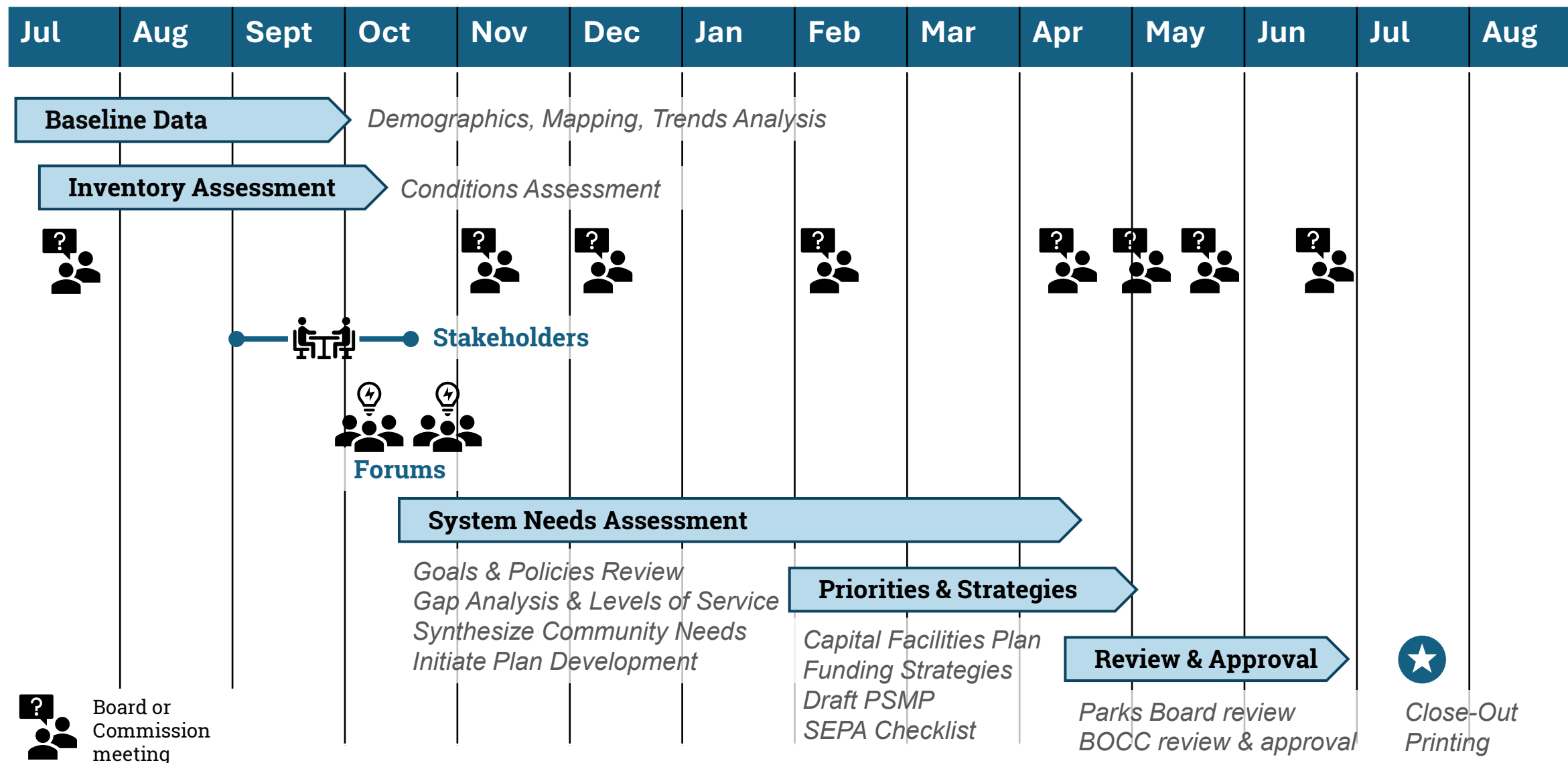
