MEETING OF THE BOARD OF EQUALIZATION (BOE)

a. Introduction of Clallam County BOE Clerk – Kami Rosser

Gores introduced Kami Rosser, Clallam County Deputy Clerk and BOE Clerk. Rosser provided her background in government. BOE provided their background.

b. Discussion regarding hearings process

Gores commented that the shotgun hearing process went well last year. Noting that not having the long pauses in between hearings was more productive for the BOE members and County staff time. BOE members had no objection to continuing with the shotgun approach for the upcoming BOE hearings.

- Gores updated that Pamela McCarter in the Assessor's Office indicated there is an audit going on in the Assessor's Office for the Current Use Program. The BOE has already received around 9 petitions for removal from the program. They anticipate there will be others coming.
