My name is Angela Kreutzer from Blue Mountain Port Angeles, WA

My comments are to make sure these facts are read into record, because I hope one day soon the proof of your knowledge of these facts will become quite valuable.

First, I am requesting the study that proves the use of masks effectively prevent the spread Covid. You know...the long term study that you have based these 'suggested' requirements on.

Now, let's review what a case is defined by, taken directly from the Clallam County Website. A confirmed case is a person who has tested positive for (SARS-CoV-2), the virus which causes (COVID-19) in humans. A positive result doesn't even mean you have Covid. It only means there is a possibility that you maybe might get it. Maybe.

Now regarding the PCR test. Directly on the CDC website (https://www.cdc.gov/csels/dls/locs/2021/07-21-2021-lab-alert-Changes_CDC_RT-PCR_SARS-CoV-2_Testing_1.html) it says they are pulling the PCR test approval request from the FDA. Why is that? Because it has a 90% false positive result. 90% of the positive 'cases' are actually negative.

Which leads me to our local numbers, pulled directly from the Clallam County website. There are 1,710 Confirmed cases. Clallam County's population is 78,891. Even using those 90% over inflated numbers, that is a miniscule 2% of our population MAYBE MIGHT get Covid. With a grand total of 17 deaths for the last year and a half, that are claimed to be Covid, that makes the chance of death in this county .02%. That is 2 100th of a percent risk of dying of COVID. That means everyone in this community has a 99.98% survival rate. Now, before you start saying 'wait. wait. let's think of those that were hospitalized.' That was a total of 91 people for the last year and a half. That is .1% chance of even getting sick enough to need hospital care. That is a 99.9% chance of being just fine even if you do get Covid.

Now, before you claim you actions are based on Dr Berry's suggestion, let's take a look at her credibility. First, she relies on the same PCR test the CDC has publicly reported they pulling from approval, to create her guidance. The accuracy of a

tests seems like details she should be educated on, long before I bring it to your attention. Next, she is using The Peninsula Daily News as her own private platform to willfully lie to the public. A perfect example is the article in: Woman in her 80's dies of Covid

(https://www.facebook.com/permalink.php?story_fbid=4432716160094551&id=100004171068174&substory_index=21), in which the deceased woman's daughter, Brooke, comments that the entire article is full of lies. Dr Berry also claims the vaccine is safe and effective, yet the VAERS database, which accounts for only about 1% of events being reported, says that more than 5,000 people have died as a direct result of Covid Shot. When the risk is scaled up 99% and the positive covid cases are scaled down 90%, it means the cure that Dr Berry is pushing is a far greater risk than this virus ever could be. Citizens must be informed honestly and truthfully, to give informed consent. Dr Berry is a liar and her credibility is zero.

You, Board of Commissioners, know these numbers and facts and yet you willfully pretend there is something to fear. You, Board of Commissioners, are entirely responsible for the ongoing physical, emotional and financial damage being done to the citizens you took an oath to represent. Shame on you.

To the Commissioners of Clallam County,

I don't have a lot to say, as I don't have much current hope for any sanity in our current local government. When lockdowns first came, (during our two weeks to flatten the curve) my wife and I gathered tons of information and forwarded it to you, and it was all ignored. We shared data straight from the CDC which defied the narrative at the time, we shared quotes from the most esteemed epidemiologists in the world, we informed you of the guaranteed suffering and excess death that lockdowns would bring, and we reminded you that government edicts are not law. It was all ignored by everyone we sent it to, save one man on the PA city council. Mr. Ozias, whom we both voted for, seemed disturbingly caught up in federal partisan politics while he was ignoring us. I don't like to assume inside of people's heads, but how else could someone have a speech on facebook about 'Stay home or you will kill grandma', and then, the very next day, take part in a protest with hundreds of people? Whatever the reason, integrity does not seem available, or even remotely possible. This was the first bad sign of many to come. (For the record, I attended the same protest as Mr. Ozias, as we share that particular issue in common).

I have watched on the documented record, as our local health official has made outlandish and unscientific fearful claims such as "Covid is 100 times more deadly than the flu". In hindsight, it is clear that she was regurgitating theories and models, while ignoring the actual scientific data, as all public health officials were doing at that time. I would even guess that the true number, (which is an Infection Fatality Rate of two/tenths of one percent.... essentially a bad flu season) after a year and a half and after meta-study on top of meta-study, is still unknown to all of you and her. Surely, I hope I am wrong with my guess. I no longer attempt to understand why Science is being ignored, or why Big Pharma Science seems to hold a monopoly on truth with you. I no longer attempt to understand why there is no accountability for outlandishly fraudulent (or ignorant) claims.

But the thing is... Even if our health official was correct with all of her bizarre claims, and if I was wrong about all the science I presented (which I wasn't, as I have followed the 65,000 scientists and medical health professionals who signed The Great Barrington Declaration, who have been proven correct many times over), you still don't have the right to do the things that you did. You should still be ashamed at the things you have promoted, and continue to promote. None of us get to decide medical decisions for others, whether that is a mask or an experimental vaccine. It is downright scary what our local government could have been capable of, if the sheriff's department shared your disregard of our constitutional

rights.

The State is not your boss. The Fed is not your boss. We are. We don't care about you losing funding. After all, we lost ours, in order to stand on principle.

We, personally, lost our jobs because of government decree. We lost our business for over a year, and we lost nearly all of our income. We pulled our child out of school, so that he did not have to adhere to any distancing or masking or vaccine coercion or other abuses. And still, we do not advocate for ourselves. We advocate for those who are still suffering from your edicts. We advocate for those who don't have the means to lose their jobs and take up homeschooling and do everything they can to avoid the abuses of the state that never seem to end. We advocate for those trying to get basic medical care for themselves, but still have to contend with ridiculous rules and severely poor service from a never ending 'state of emergency'. We advocate for the children in the schools who are still bullied into fearing a disease that is 3X less deadly than the common flu for them!!

What we need is a local government with some backbone. With integrity. With full disclosure of the scientific data they are using, and with open scientific debate allowed and encouraged. With the ability and courage to lead by example, rather than by edict.

But what we have seen is a local government that appears to take orders from above, whether that is for contact tracing, experimental medical treatment coercion, or any other tyrannical whim. Remember your place. You are a public servant.

I wrote because people want me to use my voice. All I can say is that we, and the many who are aligned with us, will use any peaceful means to get you either Out of Office.. or to remember your Oath of Office... or to understand and acknowledge the Nuremberg Code and take it seriously.
